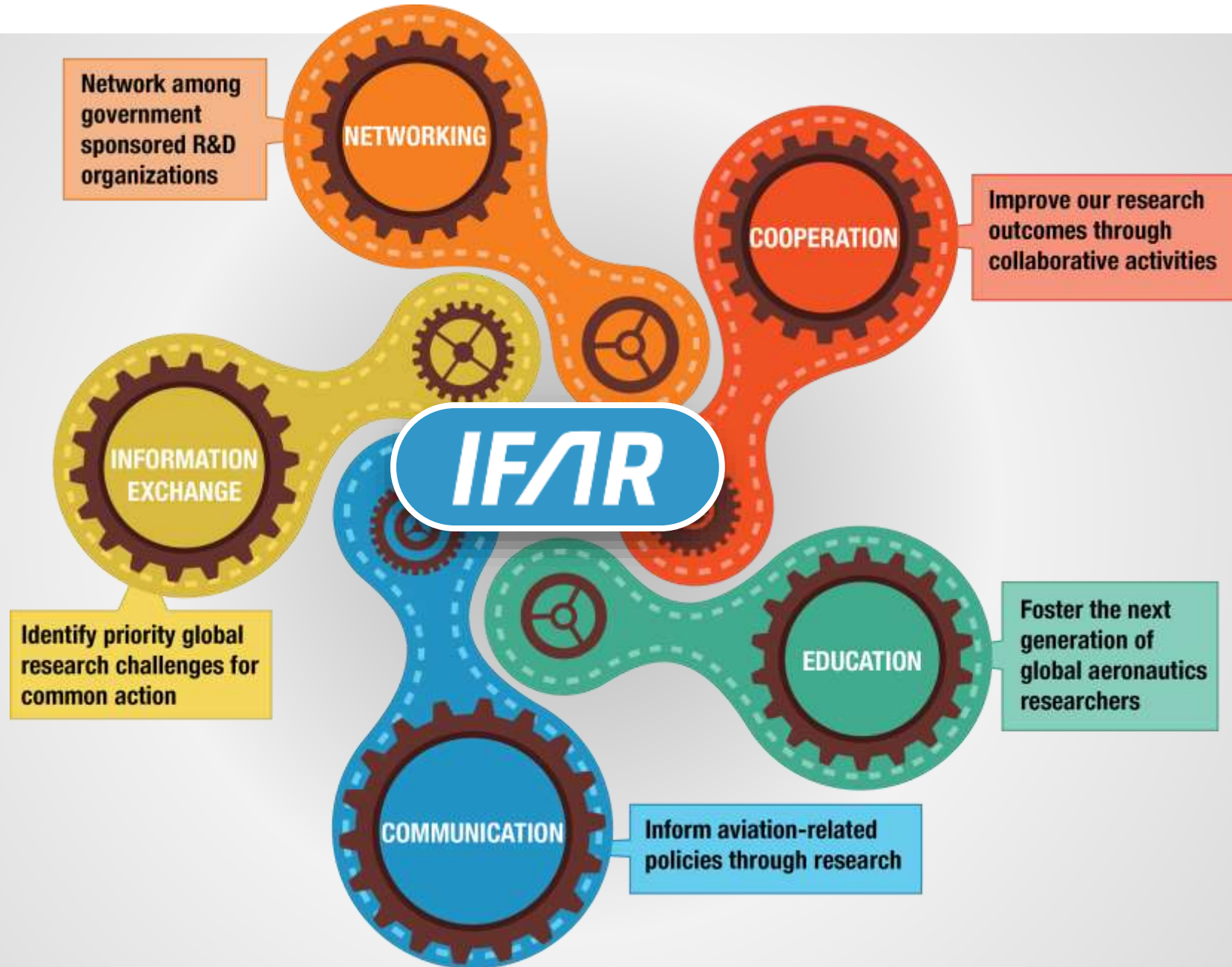


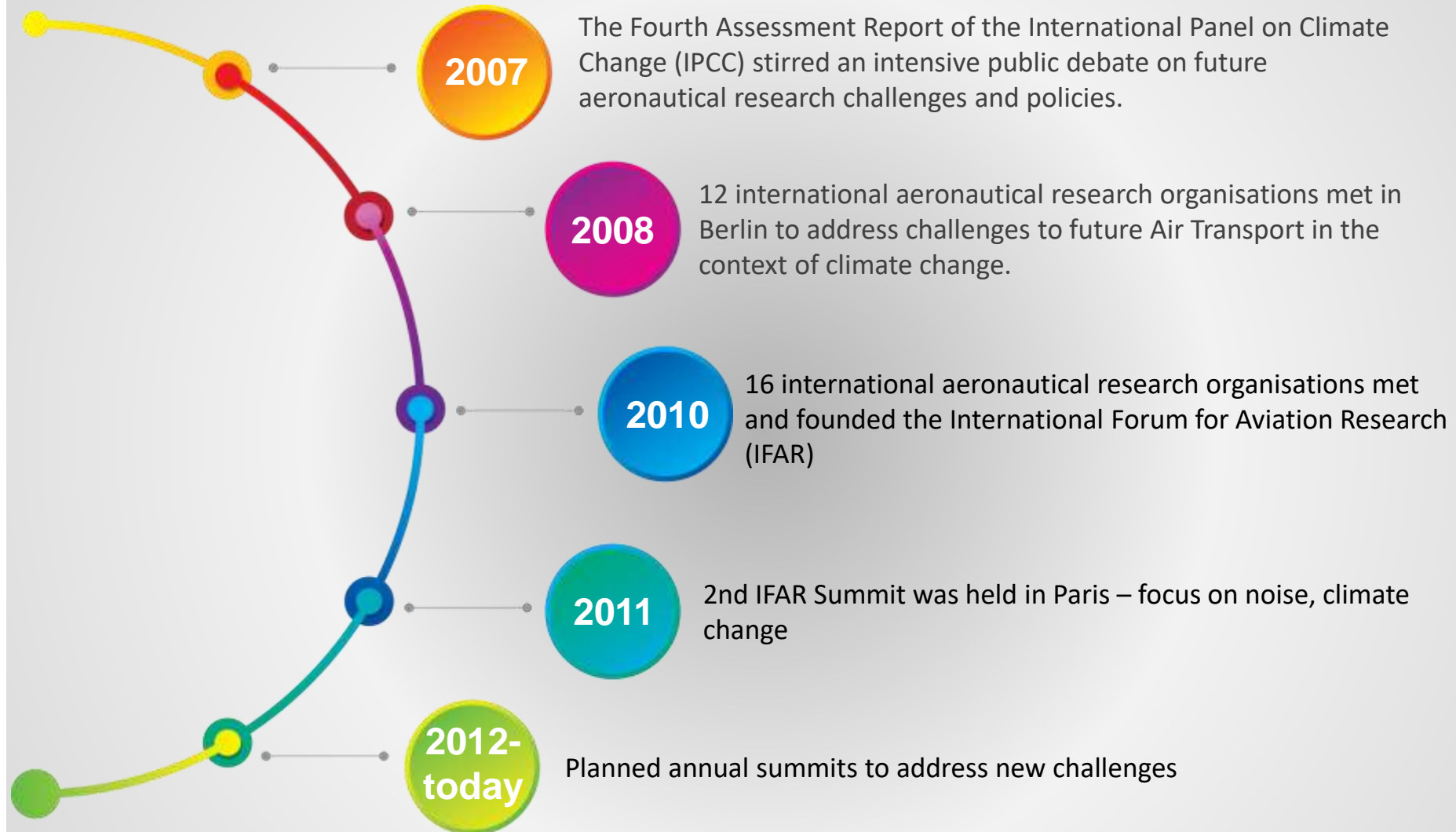
Currently **26** aviation research organizations from all over the world are members of IFAR

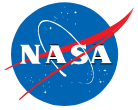
