

Anders Gustafsson (born 1943) has been involved with aeronautics for over 50 years. After graduating from KTH (Royal Institute of Technology) in Stockholm 1968 with a MSc in aeronautical engineering he worked for one year at KTH Aeronautics Department. In 1969 he joined FFA (Aeronautical Research Institute of Sweden) where he worked on aerodynamic computational methods and later with air transport system studies. From 1977 onward he served in various management positions at FFA including aerodynamics, flight systems and wind energy. From 1990 onward he was Director International Relations at FFA. This was a period when the European Union aeronautics research program started and when the Association of European Research Establishments in Aeronautics (EREA) was established. Mr Gustafsson was strongly involved in many international groups and committees in this context. FFA merged in 2001 with another Swedish organization into FOI (Swedish Defence Research Agency). He served as Director Vehicle Technologies and Aeronautics Programs at FOI until his early retirement at the end of 2003. Mr Gustafsson had then already taken up the position as ICAS Executive Secretary and served in this position 2002-2010. He has later continued, as a consultant, to work for Swedish and other European aeronautics research organizations.
